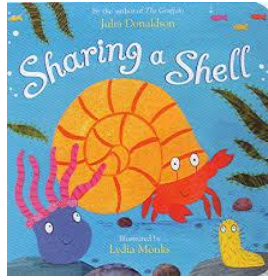


'Sharing a Shell' Home Learning for Reception



Reading

- Can you retell some of the story using the 'story sequencing cards'?
- Read the 'under the sea sentence cards' to someone in your family.
- Complete the 'under the sea word search'.

Writing

- Use the 'under the sea description writing template' to write a sentence about one of the sea creatures.
- Write some rhyming words on the rhyming word worksheet.
- Write some sentences about what you can see under the sea (writing stimulus picture)

Maths

- Complete the 'under the sea addition worksheet'. Write out your number sentences.
- Complete the 'under the sea I spy and add' worksheet.
- Can you do some fair and equal sharing at home? For example, share 6 toys between yourself and an adult.

Extra Learning

- Science: Can you complete one of the 'under the sea science experiments'?
- Music: Can you sing some of the 'ocean songs and rhymes'?
- PE: Can you use the 'ocean animal movement cards' to move like a sea creature?
- Phonics: can you play the under the sea 'I spy with my little eye' game?
- Art: If you have some paint, complete the 'mermaid handprint craft'
- Art: Can you draw or paint a picture of a rock pool?
- PSHE: How does it make you feel if people don't share with you? How do you think other people feel if you don't share with them? What could we do if we see someone not sharing?
- Geography/Computing: What facts can you research and find out about the seaside?
