

## **'Bog Baby' Home Learning for Reception**



### **Reading**

- What happened at the beginning? Middle? End of the story?
- What was your favourite part of the story? Why?
- Use the simplified version to learn the words off by heart! Ask an adult to help you.  
Make actions to help you remember and practise every day! If you want to, draw a story map to help you remember the words.

### **Writing**

- Write a set of instructions, telling me how to take care of a Bog Baby.
- Look at the pictures of the forest, can you write some words or sentences to describe it?
- Can you draw a picture of the Bog Baby and label the different body parts?
- CHALLENGE: after you've learnt the story, retell it by writing it all down!

### **Maths**

- Ask someone at home to teach you how to read the times on the clocks. Can you read them again, on your own this time? (see worksheet)
- Keep checking the time at home. Can you spot when it's 9 o'clock? 12 o'clock? 3 o'clock? 6 o'clock?
- What time do you wake up in the morning? What time do you eat lunch? What time do you go to bed?
- Complete the money jar worksheet.

### **Extra Learning**

- Art: Design and draw/create your own bog creature! When you've finished drawing your picture or creating your model, I want you to tell someone one thing you like about it and one thing that you could improve (make even better!)
