

# Craft Instructions

## Cardboard Tube Tiger

### Supplies

- Small cardboard tube
- Orange pipe cleaner
- Tiger template
- PVA glue
- Orange and black paint
- Paintbrush
- Coloured pencils or felt-tip pens
- Black felt-tip pen
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Googly eyes (optional)

First, paint the cardboard tube orange and allow to dry.

Now take the tiger templates; you will need two sets of legs and a head. You can either use the pre-coloured ones or colour

Next, carefully cut out the tiger templates. This can be a little tricky, so you may need an adult to help you. Make sure you don't cut off the tabs!

in your own using coloured pencils or felt-tip pens. Then draw a face onto the tiger's head using the black felt-tip pen. You could also stick some googly eyes on if you have them.

Now, fold over the tabs on the head and leg templates.

Once the orange tube is dry, draw or paint some black stripes all around it.

Carefully push the leg tabs through the slots and fold the tabs over. Secure with a little sticky tape.

Next, carefully cut two slots into the underside of the tube, near each end, you may need an adult to help you.

Finally, cut a piece of pipe cleaner to be your tiger's tail. Fix the tail inside the other end of the tube using a little sticky tape.

Step 1. First, paint the cardboard tube orange and allow to dry.
