Dear Parents and Carers,

There are some exciting end of year events that will take place for our Year 6s; here is more detail on each one. **In order for these events to run smoothly, it is important that children arrive on time and parents sharing in these celebrations are not late. ## **Y6 graduation - Tuesday 16th July, 9-10am (school will still start at 8:30)**

This will take place in the playground, or in the school hall if there is rain. The children will be given gowns and hats to wear; you will be able to take photos of them and celebrate their time at St Matthias.
